


5 & 6 DAYS - JUNE-SEPTEMBER

Idaho's most famous mountain, wilderness, and whitewater river. Challenging rapids, crystal clear water, Native American cultural sites, pioneer history, "blue ribbon" dry fly fishing for wild Westslope cutthroat trout, natural hot springs. National Wild and Scenic River inside the vast Frank Church — River of No Return Wilderness. Headquarters: Stanley, ID.



Owyhee Canyonlands

4 & 5 DAYS - LATE APRIL TO MID-MAY

Great spring rafting through remote backcountry. Beautiful basalt-rhyolite canyons tower over the rafts. Exhilarating rapids, fabulous scenery, natural hot springs, desert bighorn sheep, waterfowl, birds of prey, homesteader history. Native American petroglyphs, and fields of wild flowers. The Owyhee is a National Wild and Scenic River. Headquarters is Boise, ID.

The Owyhee flows through a vast, remote desert region. Water conditions vary annually.











Wallowa-Grande Ronde

4 DAYS = MAY-MID-JULY

Two of Oregon's most pristine backcountry rivers. Basalt canyons rise 4,000 feet above river level. Dense forest alternates with lush grasslands. Camps are shaded with towering ponderosa pines and douglas fir. Swift current with medium difficulty rapids are great fun. Grande Ronde is a National Wild and Scenic River. Headquarters: Lewiston, ID, or Minam, OR.

TRIP DATES: Groups can schedule trips on dates of your choice during May and early June.

Wallowa-Grande Ronde trips are normally planned for 4 days/3 nights. 3 Day trips are available. Contact Hughes Office for information and dates.

Dates: Late May and first week of June.

4 Day Trip: \$1500/adult; \$1375/youth 3 Day Trip: \$1300/adult; \$1175/youth

Deposits to Confirm: \$450/person (4 days), \$400/person (3 days)




50th Anniversary of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act

Middle Fork Salmon is one of the "original eight" included for protection.

2018 is the 50th anniversary of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act. Created by Congress in 1968, the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System was enacted to "preserve certain rivers with outstanding natural, cultural, and recreational values in the free-flowing condition for the enjoyment of present and future generations." Middle Fork of the Salmon was one of the "original eight Wild and Scenic Rivers" in 1968. The Middle Fork is often referred to as the "crown jewel" of the Wild and Scenic Act. Idaho and

Oregon Wild and Scenic Rivers that Hughes River Expeditions, Inc. outfits on include: Middle Fork of the Salmon, Owyhee River, and Grande Ronde River. The Salmon River Canyons (Lower Salmon) have been studied for inclusion, and will hopefully be included in the Wild and Scenic River system. Hughes River Expeditions encourages all our guests to support Wild and Scenic Rivers and our irreplaceable Public Lands managed by the National Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, and the National Park Service.
