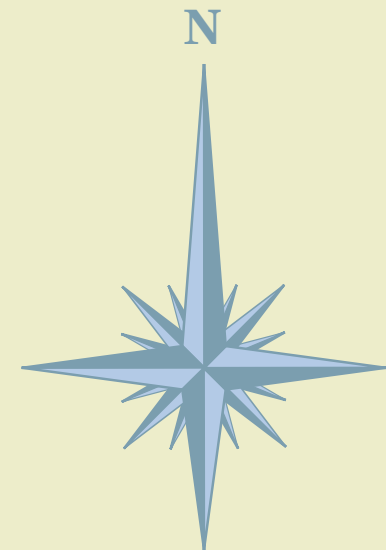

Main Salmon River

6 DAYS ■ JUNE-SEPTEMBER

The Main Salmon – River of No Return is an Idaho icon inside the Frank Church and Gospel Hump Wilderness areas. Class III-IV rapids include Black Creek, Bailey, Five Mile, Split Rock, Big Mallard, Elkhorn, Dried Meat, Chittam, Vinegar Creek, and more. The campsites are among the best in the West. Visit long-abandoned homesteads and orchards, hot springs, miner artifacts, and Native American pictographs. The Main has more historic sites than any other Idaho river. Headquarters: Missoula, MT.

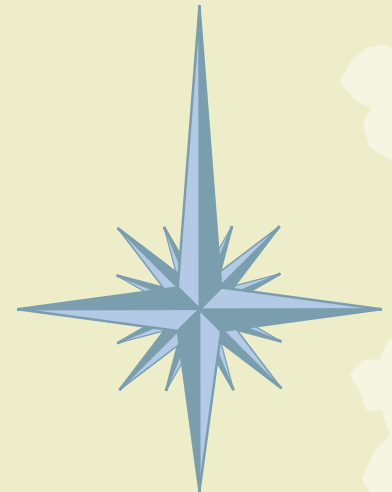

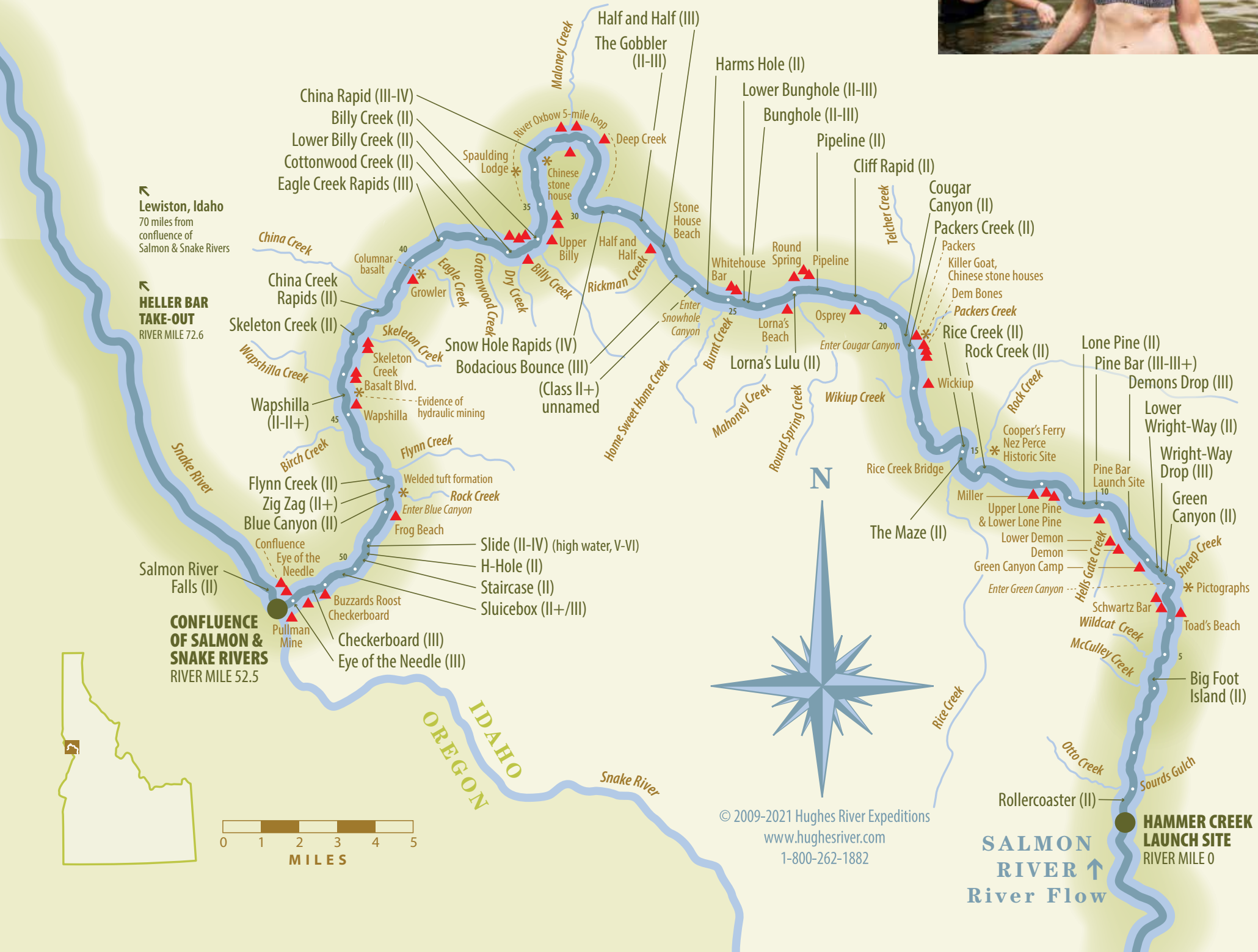

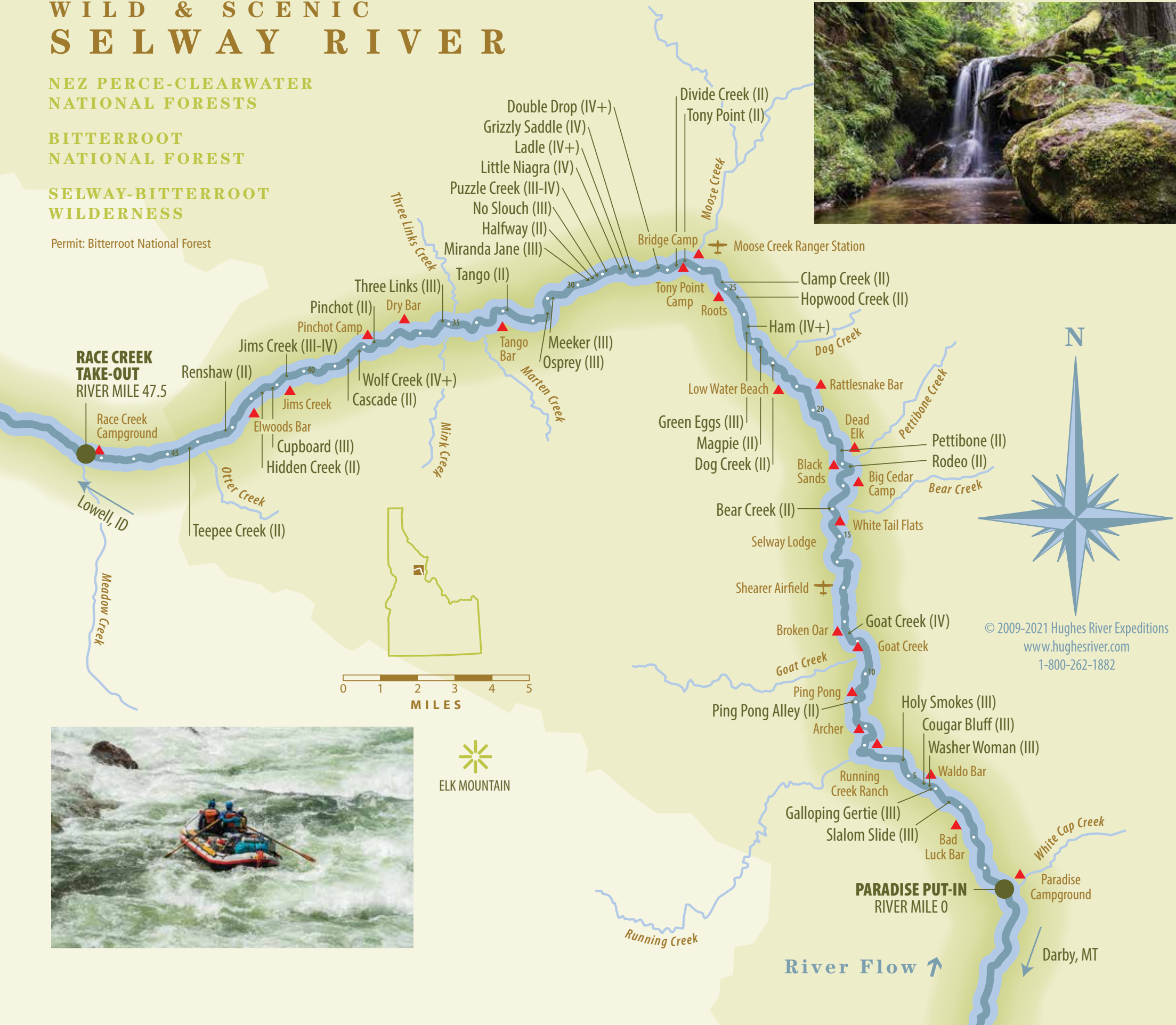

1 Spring Wildlife Viewing, Photography and Spring Break Special

Observe and photograph deer, elk, rocky mountain bighorn sheep, and goats in the Main Salmon- River of No Return wilderness corridor on their migration from low elevation wintering grounds toward high mountain summer range. Bring your camera, binoculars, hiking shoes, and warmies. If you are looking for something to do before or after the trip, bring your ski gear and head up to Whitefish, MT to enjoy a couple days on the slopes.

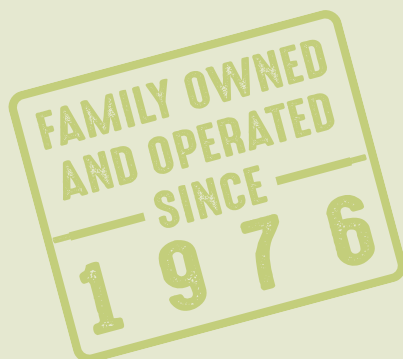

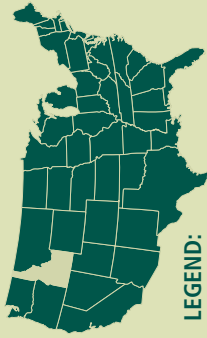
